

**ORDINANCE NO. 1-2008**

**AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING RULES FOR THE ORGANIZATION, TRAINING, ADMINISTRATION, CONTROL AND CONDUCT OF THE VILLAGE OF ANSONIA AUXILIARY POLICE UNIT AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 9-2006**

**WHEREAS** the Village of Ansonia, Darke County, Ohio, wishes to prescribe rules for the organization, training, administration, control and conduct of the Village Auxiliary Police unit in accordance with Section 2 of Ordinance 4-2006.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Ansonia, Darke County, Ohio, that:

**SECTION ONE**

This document is for the purpose of establishing rules for the organization, training, administration, control and conduct of the Ansonia Auxiliary Police unit.

**SECTION TWO**

All Auxiliary Police Officers will be sworn in upon their acceptance and completion of training. Auxiliary Officers, while on duty, are to be viewed as law enforcement officers and each officer's conduct must at all times be totally professional.

**SECTION THREE**

The Chief of Police, or his or her designee, will serve as the liaison between the Police Department and the Auxiliary Officers.

**SECTION FOUR**

Any person desiring to become an Auxiliary Police Officer may submit an application to the Chief of Police who will retain all applications.

**SECTION FIVE**

Auxiliary Police Officer appointments may be terminated by the Mayor for cause or without cause. The Village of Ansonia is an at will employer and all Auxiliary Police Officers are at will employees. Any termination by the Mayor either for cause or without cause will be with the advice and consent of the Council.

Nothing in this legislation is deemed to be construed as a contract of employment.

The council hereby confirms the following officers, Brett Coulter, Steve Votto, and Tracy Cooper as members of the Auxiliary Police Unit. Other officers may be added to this list in the future.


**SECTION SIX**

Ordinance No. 9-2006 is hereby repealed.


**SECTION SEVEN**
