

ORDINANCE NO. 6-2007

**AN ORDINANCE LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR
SIDEWALKS, CURBS AND GUTTERS PLACED ALONG MAIN
STREET AS PART OF THE MAIN STREET RECONSTRUCTION
PROJECT IN THE VILLAGE OF ANSONIA, OHIO**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Council of the Village of Ansonia, Darke County,
State of Ohio, that:

SECTION ONE

The list of estimated assessments of the cost of constructing certain sidewalks, curbs and gutters along Main Street in the Village of Ansonia, Ohio, reported to this Council and now on file in the Office of the Finance Director and aggregating \$222,015.69 are adopted and confirmed.

SECTION TWO

The several amounts of the assessments are hereby assessed and levied on the lots and lands bounding and abutting the improvement

SECTION THREE

It is determined that the assessments do not exceed the special benefits resulting from the improvement, and do not exceed any statutory limitation.

SECTION FOUR

The Clerk of Council is directed to continue on file in her office a list of the assessments, and the description of the lots and lands.

SECTION FIVE

The total assessment against each lot and parcel of land shall be payable in cash to the Finance Director of the Village of Ansonia within thirty days after passage of this Ordinance or, at the option of the property owner, assessed in ten annual installments with interest at a rate to be determined by the sale of bonds. All assessments and installments which have not been paid at the expiration of the thirty day period shall be certified by the Finance Director to the Darke County Auditor, to be placed by her on the tax duplicate and collected the same as other taxes, as provided by law.

SECTION SIX

The Clerk of Council is directed to cause notice of the passage of this Ordinance to be published as provided by law.

SECTION SEVEN

The Clerk of Council is directed to cause notice of the levy of the assessments herein to be filed with the Darke County Auditor within forty-five days following the passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION EIGHT


This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
