

**RESOLUTION 5-2007**

**A RESOLUTION TENTATIVELY AWARDING THE CONTRACT FOR THE VILLAGE OF ANSONIA, OHIO, COMBINED SEWER SEPARATION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Ansonia has applied for and is anticipating funding from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's Water Pollution Control Loan Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to receive funding from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's Water Pollution Control Loan Fund, pending approval of the Ohio Water Development Authority, the Village must tentatively award a contract to the apparent successful bidder for the Combined Sewer Separation Project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Ansonia, Ohio, that:

**SECTION ONE**

The Council of the Village of Ansonia hereby tentatively awards the contract for the Combined Sewer Separation Project to the apparent successful bidder, Demmy Construction of Springfield, Ohio.

**SECTION TWO**

This Resolution to tentatively award a contract shall be non binding on the Village of Ansonia as its purpose is to satisfy a requirement of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency.

**SECTION THREE**

This Resolution is deemed to be an emergency measure necessary to meet time constraints to receive funding from the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency.
